COVID UPDATE: As restrictions are relaxed across the country, we have received updated guidance from the Diocese:

- Anyone displaying symptoms of Covid-19 should stay at home and not travel to church.
- **It will no longer be necessary to book places for Sunday Mass at St Cuthbert's.**
- All visitors to church should continue to use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit, and **continue to wear masks** if possible for the safety of all, especially the vulnerable in our churches.
- While good ventilation will be maintained throughout our buildings, in order to try to keep the buildings warm during these winter months, not all the doors and windows will need to be opened at every Mass.
- As touch transmission has been shown to be minimal, the use of hymn books, missals and other aids will be resumed.

Our aim is to continue to keep all parishioners safe while trying to return, as much as possible, to a more normal way of living.



WORLD DAY OF PRAYER: We hope to have a socially-distanced day of prayer this year, to be held at St Laurence's Church, Frodsham, on **Friday, 4th March** at 1.30 pm. We are to have a planning meeting for the Service on **Tuesday, 8th February** at 1:30pm in S. Laurence's. Rev. Elaine Attack, Vicar of Frodsham, will be there to welcome us and answer any questions. The service this year has been prepared by the women of England, Wales and Northern Ireland. The theme is 'I know the plans I have for you' from God's promise to his people in exile in Babylon, found in the book of Jeremiah 29:11. Please let Aelison know if you can come to the planning meeting and/or Service. It would be good to have a strong representation from St Luke's.
