EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS' new rota is now ready in the porch.

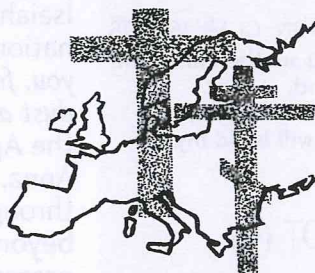
