ST LUKE'S MISSION TOGETHER STATEMENT: Thank you for your on-going support of Our Mission Together. Your generosity is giving us ways and means with which we can support and foster the mission of our Church here in St Luke's Frodsham. Our plan is to use the funds we retain to improve the ascetics of the Church to encompass a more prayerful and welcoming place and the presbytery to enable the well-being of the resident priest. This will help the Parish to concentrate on the spiritual aspects of our faith and welcome new parishioners and the local community to participate in our worship. So far, we have replaced the two window frames in the east of the sanctuary area, which now includes an opening window that will allow a good flow of air during the summer months. With a service, the heating system is working more reliably, keeping us all warm, new CCTV has been installed for better security of the property and the railings in the front of the Church has been stripped back and painted. In the presbytery, new windows and doors have been installed to replace with ones creating a draft and sound-proof atmosphere.

Negotiation on a new sign-board informing the local community of mass times and school are on-going. We look forward to keeping you updated as our project continues to develop. Please continue to support Our Mission Together and pray for our clergy, our parishes and those in need around us.
