First Reading: Isaiah 52:13-53:12

Psalm: Ps 30:2. 6. 12-13. 15-17. 25. R. Luke 23:46

Response: Father, into your hands I commend my spirit.

Second Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16; 5:7-9

Gospel Acclamation:

Praise to you O Christ, King of eternal glory.

Christ was humbler yet, even to accepting death, death on a cross.
But God raised him high, and gave him the name which is above all
names.

Praise to you O Christ, King of eternal glory.

Gospel: The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John
At the words 'he gave up his spirit.' All kneel for a few moments.

The Solemn Intercessions:

THE ADORATION OF THE HOLY CROSS:

As the Cross is unveiled or shown, the deacon or priests says three times:

Deacon: Behold the wood of the Cross, on which hung the salvation
of the world.

All: Come, let us adore.

*After the priest has revered the Cross,
the people adore the Cross in stillness either kneeling or sitting.*

HOLY COMMUNION:

The Blessed Sacrament is brought to the altar.

Priest: At the Saviour's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say:

All: Our Father, who art in heaven ...

Priest: Deliver us, Lord, we pray, ... and the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

All: For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and for ever.

Priest: Lord Jesus Christ, who said to your Apostles: ... Who live and reign for ever and ever.

All: Amen.

Priest: Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

All: Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

The priest shows the Host to the people and says:

Priest: The Body of Christ.

All: Amen.
