The season of creation is a time to attend to our world, to celebrate its beauty and respect its delicacy, and to join others in coming to its defence.

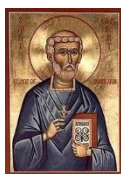

ST CUTHBERT, bishop (634–687): This “Child of God”, as St Bede describes him, was a monk at Melrose before becoming bishop of Lindisfarne. He devoted himself to his flock, helping with alms and advice and visiting all parts of his large diocese. His need for solitude and his love of nature drew him to the desolate island of Farne, where he died. His feast day falls on 4th September – Happy Feast Day to all our St Cuthbert’s parishioners!
