

WALKS OF WITNESS: On Good Friday there will be Walks of Witness in both Frodsham and Mouldsworth. The Mouldsworth walk will **begin at St Cuthbert's at 10am**. The walk will **finish at St John's in Ashton**, where light refreshments will be available. Meanwhile, the Churches of Frodsham will meet outside Main St Community Church at **10am** to walk with the cross along Main St and up Church St to St Laurence's, pausing to pray at Eddisbury Square. At **11am**, following coffee and hot cross buns at St Laurence's, the cross will make its way to the top of Frodsham Hill for a short service of reflection as it is placed by the War Memorial. You are welcome to join either of these walks to remember Jesus' journey to the cross.



EASTER SUNDAY: There will be a short service of resurrection at 7am on Easter Sunday morning at Frodsham Methodist Church, followed by breakfast. All are welcome.
