

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY: This weekend is The Most Holy Trinity – the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Through our life in Christ we live the life of the Trinity. God is a perfect community and if we model our lives on the Trinity then the God of love and peace will be with us. You might like to think about some of the things that we do when we make the Sign of the Cross: Pray; Open ourselves to grace; Sanctify the day; Commit the whole self to Christ; Recall the Incarnation; Remember the Passion of the Lord; and Affirm the Trinity.

TAKING LITURGY SERIOUSLY COURSE: Module 4 of this interesting and important course begins this coming **Thursday, 8th June** in St Luke's Parish Centre, meeting at 7pm for Zoom start at 7:30pm.
