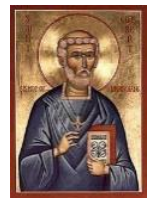

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST: This Sunday we honour the real presence of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. The Eucharist is often described as food for a pilgrim people on their journey, matching and infinitely surpassing the manna that sustained God's people in the desert. The body of Christ, made manifest in bread, connects us in a very physical way to our God. We take what he has given and we share it with those around us, the very essence of our life as a Christian people. Below is a short prayer for today:

Christ is Our Food and Drink

O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of your Passion, grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption.

THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS: Devotion to the Sacred Heart represents a devotion to Jesus in his human nature, in particular referring to the heart as the seat of the emotions. On the solemnity of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on **Friday 11th June**, there will be **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 9:10am** at St Luke's (before Mass at 9:30am).



Please keep Father James in your prayers on Monday, 7 June, on the anniversary of his ordination to the priesthood.
