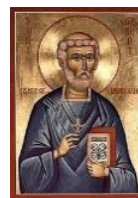

ASSISTED SUICIDE: A Bill is expected to be introduced into the House of Commons a week on Wednesday to take the first step towards euthanasia by proposing that medically assisted suicide be legalised. Please think about contacting your MP about this possible radical change to our society. A lecture on this topic will be held at the Mercure Manchester Piccadilly Hotel, Portland Street, Manchester M1 4PH from 7:30pm to 9pm on **Tuesday 22nd October** and the speaker, Dr Dominic Whitehouse, who is a palliative care consultant currently working in a hospice in Sussex, will be explaining why a change in the law would be harmful to patients, doctors and to society.
