HOLY WEEK SERVICES: This year, thankfully, the Celebrations for Holy Week and the Sacred Triduum will be in the presence of Christ's faithful, following all guidance provided by the Diocese. However, please be aware that restrictions on numbers at each service will still be in place. As this is the most important week in the Church's calendar, we expect these services will be fully booked in advance – details of the times of services will be published as soon as possible. Please remember you must still:

- wear a face covering unless medically exempt (please let the stewards know);
- socially distance from others not in your household/bubble;
- follow the one-way system if you are able (please let the stewards know if you are unable to manage the steps on exit);
- sanitise your hands on entry and exit; and
- avoid congregating in the car park before or after services.



BAPTISMS POST-LOCKDOWN: Following the government's recent announcements regarding the "roadmap" out of lockdown, please note that by Step Three, "no earlier than" 17th May 2021, weddings and baptisms may proceed with up to 30 attendees present. We have been unable to conduct any baptisms over the past year and are aware that several parishioners have been waiting for this announcement. If you wish to arrange a baptism for after 17th May, please email the office indicating this and include a mobile number; Father James will then contact you to arrange the next steps. Please keep in mind that government guidance is subject to change. Many thanks for your patience during this difficult past year.
