DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY: Celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter, concluding the Octave of Easter, this is based on the Catholic devotion to the Divine Mercy that Faustina Kowalska reported as part of her encounter with Jesus. We have a beautiful Divine Mercy picture in the sanctuary at St Luke's. The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:



A - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and on the whole world.

B - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

C - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that our reception of the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

A prayer for Divine Mercy Sunday:

*Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible,
look kindly upon us and increase your mercy in us,
that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence
submit ourselves to your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.*
