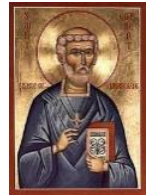

First Reading: Exodus 34: 4-6. 8-9

Psalm: Dan 3:52-56. R. v.52

Response: To you glory and praise for evermore

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 13: 11-13

Gospel Acclamation: *Alleluia, alleluia! Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, the God who is, who was, and who is to come. Alleluia!*

Gospel: John 3: 16-18

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY: This Sunday, the first Sunday after Pentecost, is Trinity Sunday, which celebrates the Christian doctrine of the Trinity, the three Persons of God: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. It is the only major Christian festival that celebrates a church doctrine rather than an event in its sacred history.

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF THE LORD: Traditionally celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday, since 2007 this solemnity has been celebrated on the following Sunday. On this day we honour the real presence of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.
