

POPE EMERITUS BENEDICT XVI (RIP): Please pray for the repose of the soul of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI who died on Saturday, 31 December 2022 at the age of 95. He was born at Marktl am Inn, Germany on 16 April 1927 (Holy Saturday) and was baptised on the same day. He received his priestly ordination on 29 June 1951 and began to teach. On 25 March 1977, Pope Paul VI named him Archbishop of Munich and Freising; later that same year he was made a Cardinal. He was part of the Conclaves which elected both John Paul I and John Paul II. Joseph Cardinal Ratzinger was elected on 19 April 2005 as the 265th Pope, the oldest person to be elected Pope since 1730. On 11 February 2013

Pope Benedict announced his decision to resign and his pontificate came to an end on 28 February 2013. After his resignation took effect, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI lived within the Vatican in the *Mater Ecclesiae* Monastery until his death. The morning Mass at St Luke's on **Friday, 13th January** will be a Requiem Mass offered for Pope Benedict. May he rest in peace.
