

**ST TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS:** Edith Stein was born a Jewess in 1891, and became a Catholic in 1922. A teacher, lecturer and writer, she longed for the solitude of Carmel and entered in 1933. During the Jewish persecution she transferred from Cologne Carmel to Echt in Holland in order to protect nuns in her monastery. However, the Nazis invaded Holland and she was arrested, taken to Auschwitz and gassed in 1942. One of several Patrons of Europe, her feast day on 9<sup>th</sup> August is a Day of Special Prayer for Europe. Please add a prayer to St Teresa to your daily prayers this Monday.

**CURRENT SITUATION IN OUR CHURCHES:** Please continue to: **use hand sanitiser** on entry and exit to the church buildings; **wear face masks** if you are able; and make use of the "Please Leave a Space" cards provided if necessary. The numbers allowed have been increased slightly but you should continue to book your place at Mass through Chris on the usual number until further notice.
