PALM SUNDAY: This Sunday at the 11:00am Mass at St Luke's the Mass and opening ceremony will begin in the car park and we would ask that you **keep the centre of the top car park free of cars** to allow safe room for the procession. Those who are able should gather in the cloister at 10:55am.

COLLECTION FOR THE HOLY LAND: A basket for donations towards the annual collection to support the Church in the Holy Land will be available in the church porch throughout the Sacred Triduum. Please don't forget the plight of Christians in the Holy Land who have been even more isolated during the last couple of years of the pandemic.



WALKS OF WITNESS: On Good Friday there will be Walks of Witness in both Frodsham and Mouldsworth. The Mouldsworth walk will **begin at St Cuthbert's at 10am**. The walk will **finish at St John's in Ashton**, where light refreshments will be available. Meanwhile, the Churches of Frodsham will be taking a cross to the top of Frodsham hill starting from **St Laurence's Church**. There will be Easter crafts for children between 10am and 12 noon, while coffee and hot cross buns for those embarking on the **journey with the cross will be at 11am**. You are welcome to join either of these walks to remember Jesus' journey to the cross.

SYNODAL REPORT: The *Diocesan Listening Phase* has now come to a close. The final Synodal Report, together with a Discernment by Bishop Mark, can be found on our website at: https://www.stlukesparish.org.uk/?page_id=2035. The document and a video of Bishop Mark's Discernment will also be available on the Diocesan website shortly. Thanks were expressed to all who helped and contributed to this process amid the challenges of the pandemic. The synodal pathway now moves to the national and continental levels, as has been mapped out, in preparation for the International Synod of Bishops in October 2023.

POVERTY CHALLENGE: SEE, JUDGE, ACT: Following the pandemic, many households now also face new hardships as prices rise. Caritas Social Action Network (CSAN), the Catholic agency addressing poverty and injustice in England and Wales, has released a free new booklet to increase awareness of Catholic Social Teaching on poverty, and to inform local responses.
