

 **REST IN PEACE:** Please pray for the happy repose of the soul of **Ellie Thomas**, a parishioner of St Luke's who died on Thursday, 25<sup>th</sup> May, aged 95 years. Ellie's Requiem Mass will take place at St Luke's on **Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> June** at **10:30am**, followed by burial at Helsby Cemetery. Please keep Ellie and all her family and friends in your prayers at this time. May she rest in peace.

**FEAST OF ST ANTHONY:** Since the Tuesday on which St Anthony's body was laid to rest in Padua in 1231, Tuesday has been St Anthony's day. The devotion of the Nine Tuesdays in St Anthony's honour began in the sixteenth century. St Anthony appeared to a woman who suffered from a painful disease and counselled her to pray at his shrine in the Franciscan Church, to confess her sins, and to receive Holy Communion on nine consecutive Tuesdays. She did so, and on the ninth Tuesday, she was cured. The story of the cure led to the general adoption of the Nine Tuesdays as a means of invoking St Anthony's aid. *Each Tuesday after the evening Mass we share a devotion to St Anthony. This coming Tuesday is the Feast of St Anthony of Padua, so please join us if you can for Mass and devotion on this special day.*
