

LIFTING OF LOCKDOWN RESTRICTIONS: The Prime Minister indicated this week that he envisaged lockdown restrictions in England being lifted from Monday, 19th July. This is expected to be confirmed on Monday, 12th July. The Governmental Task Force for Places of Worship in England will meet next week and we can anticipate that there will be advice forthcoming for churches. **It is likely that there will be a phased return to normality** rather than seeking to return to all pre-lockdown practice immediately. Please be assured we will take all advice and local circumstances into account when making decisions on lifting restrictions in our own churches.

The application process has been prolonged this year due to the public health crisis and final decisions on readiness will be made next month. Two other candidates have been accepted for training for the Permanent Diaconate following a period of discernment with our Diocesan Diaconate Team. Please keep them all in your prayers.
