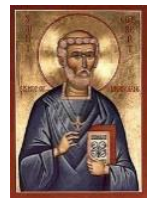

Mass times for the Holyday of Obligation are **Wednesday at 7:00pm** and **Thursday morning at 10:00am**.

**SPUC ANNUAL PETITION:** This year's SPUC petition relates to the two-child benefit cap. Sadly, one of the biggest drivers of abortion in the UK is poverty, and the current government policy on Universal Benefits in particular penalises families. It has been identified that it is "A significant factor" in many women deciding to abort their children. Postcards are available at the back of church for you to join this weekend's petition and call on the Prime Minister to end the two-child family credit cap. Completed cards left in the basket will be sent off together saving you the cost of a stamp.

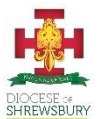
