WHITE FLOWER APPEAL 2020: The Society for the Protection of Unborn Children (SPUC) will be holding its annual appeal this weekend. On 21 October 2019 the most extreme abortion regime in Europe was imposed on the people of Northern Ireland by the government at Westminster. Abortion will now be permitted for any reason up until at least 24 weeks, and even beyond that. The abortion lobby now wants to introduce this in England and Wales. 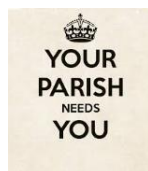
