DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY: Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter, concluding the Octave of Easter. It is based on the Catholic devotion to the Divine Mercy that Faustina Kowalska reported as part of her encounter with Jesus. We have a beautiful Divine Mercy picture in the sanctuary at St Luke's. The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:



- **A Ask** for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.
- **B Be merciful**. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.
- **C Completely trust** in Jesus. God wants us to know that our reception of the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.
