OUR MISSION TOGETHER NEWSLETTER: Please take a copy at the back of the Church. This is filled with great news and updates regarding the work done by the Diocese with the generous support and help from many parishes.:

Caritas Agency of Shrewsbury – Has been able to employ two new social workers to work in the Hattersley, Hyde, Dukinfield and Wythenshawe areas to support young people who are at risk of withdrawing from school. Caritas is currently working in 16 schools in the Wirral and Runcorn addressing different issues. Also it has employed a refugee support work in the 'Well Project' which they opened in Wythenshawe.

Supporting our Clergy – It has employed a Clergy Welfare Officer, Margaret Evans, who is working closely with those approaching retirement and those retired.

Youth Mission – It has held interviews for their Youth Team and this team will be functional on 4th September.
