

**ROSARY:** During the month of October, the Rosary will be said **after the weekday morning mass** on Wednesday and Friday. Meditation of the cycles of Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and Luminous Mysteries makes the Rosary not only a summary of the Gospel and of Christian life, but also a compendium of the Liturgical Year. Our Lady calls on us to pray this beautiful prayer for peace in our world. At St Cuthbert's, the Rosary will be said at **10:00am on Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> October**. Everyone will be made most welcome at both our churches.



**ST LUKE'S FEAST:** The Feast of St Luke will be celebrated this Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> October. Mass that day will be at **10:00am** and we will be joined by the children and staff from St Luke's Primary School. Named as the author of the third gospel and the Acts of the Apostles, St Luke wrote to reassure the early church. His gospel shows that the compassion of Christ is inclusive of all, be they rich or poor, women or men, outcast or privileged. Happy Feast Day to all!!

**GOSPEL REFLECTION:** *The purpose of prayer is not to change God's mind but to change ourselves, and we can be slow to move. When have you found that persistence in prayer strengthened your faith in the presence of God with you in that struggle? Behind the story in this week's Gospel lies the question: Who does have faith? Who have been models of faith and trust in God for you? How has that trust been shown in their lives and how is it shown in yours?*
