

LOURDES NEWS: Bishop Mark would like to record his thanks to John Campbell, who has recently retired as President of the Shrewsbury Diocesan Lourdes Hospitality, for his dedicated service of our pilgrimage and the care of our sick pilgrims. It is already clear that a "normal pilgrimage" will not be possible in July as sick pilgrims and school groups will be unable to travel under public health restrictions, but it is unclear whether *any* form of pilgrimage will be feasible this year, and a final decision will be taken before Easter.
