PILGRIMAGE TO THE RELICS OF SAINT BERNADETTE OF LOURDES: We would like to organise a coach trip to visit the relics of Saint Bernadette of Lourdes when they are welcomed to St Werburgh's, Chester on Wednesday 14th September. In order to arrange the correct size coach, we would be grateful if those interested could put their names and contact details on the form provided in the church porches. If you are unable to complete the form in person but would still like to join the trip, please contact the office with your name. It is hoped that this trip would include parishioners from both St Luke's & St Cuthbert's, possibly with pick up/drop off at both churches.

Born in 1844 in a small town in France, Bernadette Soubirous was one of nine children from a very poor family. Although initially unremarkable, her life was to inspire generations of people to journey in faith on pilgrimage to Lourdes. Between 11 February and 16 July 1858, Bernadette saw the Virgin Mary eighteen times in a series of Apparitions that took place in a cave on the outskirts of Lourdes, a place now known as the Grotto of Massabielle. In the course of these miraculous encounters, Bernadette, then aged just 14, became the friend and confidante of Our Lady, the mother of Jesus. The Apparitions of Lourdes were authenticated in 1866 by the Bishop of Tarbes. In that same year, Bernadette left Lourdes to live out her religious vocation within the community of the Sisters of Charity of Nevers. She died in 1879, was proclaimed blessed in 1925, and a became a saint in 1933.
