POPE FRANCIS opened the preparation for the International Synod of Bishops in Rome last Sunday which is to be held in October 2023. Bishop Mark will celebrate Mass in the Cathedral this Sunday to open the Diocesan phase. Please add the following to your prayers:

The Prayer of the Synod: Adsumus Sancte Spiritus: We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions. Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.
