

LIFTING OF LOCKDOWN RESTRICTIONS: As of **Monday, 19th July**, the government is lifting many of its restrictions imposed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We will be following a phased return to "normal" and will keep you informed as things change. From next week the following changes will be introduced in our churches:

- Please **continue to use hand sanitiser** on entry and exit to the church buildings.
- Please **continue to wear face masks**, for your safety and for the safety of others.
- Windows and doors will continue to be opened in order to provide adequate ventilation.
- There will **no longer be a booking system** in place. You should use the NHS Covid app to scan the QR Code in the porch as you arrive at St Luke's; at St Cuthbert's and if you are unable to use the QR Code at St Luke's, please enter your name and contact number on the list provided so you can be contacted should the need arise.
- The distribution of Holy Communion will now take place at the more normal time in Mass and you will be able to return to your seats afterwards. Please keep your mask in place, step to the side as far as you are able to consume the host, then replace your mask and return to your seat. Please be considerate of others and try to avoid crowding together.
- "Please Leave a Space" cards will be available in the porch for those who are feeling nervous about sitting too close to others. Take a card and place it on the bench next to you; if you see the card on the bench please be considerate and leave a gap between you and the next person.
- Standing at the back of church or in the porch is still not allowed so if there is no seat available we ask that you try again another week.

While the Sunday Obligation has not yet been reinstated, all those who are able and not shielding are encouraged by the bishops to try to attend weekend masses were at all possible.
