The post has now been vacant since 30th April 2022. Under the Modern Slavery Act, the Commissioner has a: "UK-wide remit to encourage good practice in the prevention, detection, investigation and prosecution of modern slavery offences and the identification of victims." Would you please pray daily with us for the Secretary of State to make an immediate appointment? Thank you for joining in prayer with us.
