

**OUR LADY'S POSADA 2022:** Posada is a Spanish word meaning 'journey'. In the Nativity stories, Joseph and Mary made a journey on their way to Bethlehem, where Jesus was born. Each year, our congregation celebrates that journey by recreating it in our parish. A statue of Our Lady travels round families who 'host' her for one night each until Christmas Eve when she arrives at Church for the Festival of the Nativity. Over the last few years, it has proved very popular and she has had no end of families keen to give her shelter for the night. People may light a candle by her and ask her blessing during this run-up to Christmas. It is a moment of tranquillity in the busyness of the season. She will begin her journey on 27<sup>th</sup> November, the First Sunday of Advent, when she will be blessed at the 11 am Mass.
