REFLECTIONS ON THE CHURCH: Having looked at the Council's answer to 'Who is the Church', we continue our reflections on Vatican II with the next question Lumen Gentium addresses: 'How is the Church?' — what structure did Christ will for her? The answer is given in Chapters 3 and 4, where the immense, complementary vocations of Hierarchy and Laity are explored at some length. Christ is at work in both, in such a way that "... the whole Church, strengthened by each one of its members, may more effectively fulfil his mission for the life of the world" (# 37).
