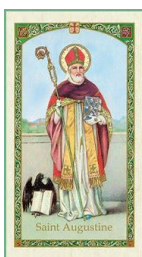

ST AUGUSTINE: Next Saturday, 28th August, is the feast of St Augustine of Hippo, bishop and doctor of the Church (354–430). Difficult and wayward in his youth and early manhood, Augustine came late to the love of God. However, he threw himself wholeheartedly into his Christian commitment and was one of the greatest bishops in the history of the Church with his See being at Hippo. He was an energetic writer with *Confessions* and *The City of God* being the most widely read. As well as being patron to many cities and dioceses throughout the world, St Augustine is also the patron saint of brewers, printers, theologians and for the alleviation of sore eyes. A day earlier, on Friday 27th, we celebrate the feast of his mother, St Monica.
