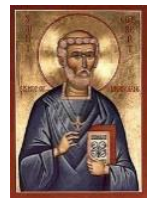

PALM SUNDAY: This Sunday at the 11:00am Mass at St Luke's, we will gather in the cloister for blessing of the palms followed by a short reading and procession into church. GOOD FRIDAY: There will be Stations of the Cross at St Luke's at 10:30am – please join us if you are able. At our 3:00pm service, during Adoration of the Cross it is considered most appropriate that the Cross should be venerated by a simple genuflection or bow. Thank you for your cooperation.
