LIFTING OF LOCKDOWN RESTRICTIONS: Our phased return to "normal" has been introduced this week; please note the following at both churches:

- Please **continue to use hand sanitiser** on entry and exit to the church buildings and **to wear face masks** if you are able, for your safety and for the safety of others.
- Windows and doors will continue to be opened in order to provide adequate ventilation.
- The distribution of Holy Communion will now take place at the more normal time in Mass and you will be able to return to your seats afterwards. Please keep your mask in place, step to the side to one of the "markings" on the floor to consume the host, then replace your mask and return to your seat. Please be considerate of others and try to avoid crowding together.
- "Please Leave a Space" cards will be available in the porch for those who are feeling nervous about sitting too close to others. Take a card and place it on the bench next to you; if you see the card on the bench please be considerate and leave a gap between you and the next person.

At St Luke's:

- Both means of exit from the church will be available to avoid any unnecessary delay in exiting the building.
- There will **no longer be a booking system** in place at St Luke's. You should use the NHS Covid-19 app to scan the QR Code in the porch as you arrive OR please enter your name and contact number on the list provided so you can be contacted should the need arise.
- More benches have been opened up to increase capacity in church. For safety reasons, we ask that you do not kneel if that will cause you to become too close to the person seated directly in front of you.
- Standing at the back of church or in the porch is still not allowed; we hope our new arrangements will accommodate our congregations safely.

At St Cuthbert's:

- The **booking system will remain in place** at St Cuthbert's for the time being. The numbers allowed have been increased slightly but you should continue to book your place at Mass through Chris on the usual number until further notice.
