POPE FRANCIS is visiting Ireland this weekend, August 25 and 26 for the **World Meeting of the Families** event. This event, in Dublin this year, is an international Catholic event that takes place every three years. The Pope will also attend Knock Shrine before holding a special mass at Dublin's Phoenix Park on August 26. All 500,000 tickets for the event were booked up within weeks of their release on June 25, with 15,000 of those attending being overseas visitors.
