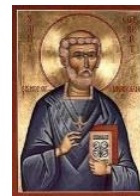

- † Holy Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> April - as there will no watching at the Altar of Repose this year due to Covid safety measures, there will be an opportunity following the Mass of the Lord's Supper to share in watching before the Tabernacle of Shrewsbury Cathedral via the website from 8:30pm to 10:30pm.

**ST CUTHBERT'S FOOD BANK COLLECTION:** There will be a Foodbank collection at St Cuthbert's this **Sunday, 28th March**. Please leave the food **ONLY ON SUNDAY** in the bin at the rear of church. If the bin is getting full please give Chris a ring. Items they need include: **Jam, Long-Life Fruit Juice, Tinned Fruit, Desserts (Jelly, Rice Pudding), Tea Bags (especially 80s), Custard, Tinned/Mashed Potatoes, and Savoury Sandwich Spreads**. They don't need: Soup, Baked Beans, Tinned Tomatoes, Tinned Snack Meals and Coffee. Thank you all in anticipation.



**FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS:** Following the government's "Pathway out of Lockdown", it is hoped that arrangements for First Confessions and First Holy Communion for some of our primary school pupils will soon be in place. While restrictions are to be slowly lifted, uncertainties do remain as to what restrictions may remain in place at each stage of the pathway.
