***Seeing your Life through the Lens of the Gospel***

- 1) *The parable brings out two contrasting experiences, but each in its own way can be a moment of grace, a moment of truth, a moment of growth. You may be able to recall such experiences in your own life: when we have claimed a place that is too high for us – we are not as selfless, generous or compassionate as we thought; or when others point out a goodness in ourselves that we may not have acknowledged, even to ourselves. How have you grown through such experiences?*
- 2) *Jesus then warns against the danger of ulterior motives in doing good. If we do good partly for the benefit we might get from what we do, this can lead to disappointment and resentment when expectations are not met. When the good deed in itself is our reward, we have a greater freedom. What does your life experience tell you about this?*
