THE MOST HOLY TRINITY: This Sunday, the first Sunday after Pentecost, is Trinity Sunday, which celebrates the Christian doctrine of the Trinity, the three Persons of God: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. We persevere in hope knowing that the love of God has been poured out into our heart by the Holy Spirit. The Spirit leads us into a deeper understanding of what the Gospel of Christ really means.

ROSARY RELAY: Many of you may have been joining the Rosary online from Walsingham shrine during May. Sunday 30th May will be a relay Rosary through all the dioceses of England, Wales and Scotland in which Shrewsbury will take its part from 2.00pm to 3.00pm. CHANGES AT MASS DUE TO STEP 3 GUIDELINES: Recent changes to guidelines mean we have been able to increase the maximum numbers allowed in both our churches to 55 at St Luke's and 23 at St Cuthbert's, depending on the size of different households/bubbles in attendance. As Track & Trace information is still currently a government requirement, please continue to book your place to help ensure we comply with this requirement as well as to avoid disappointment. Full details of the changes can be found in last week's newsletter but the main change is as follows:

- Father James will now announce to **each** communicant "The Body of Christ" and you should reply "Amen". For your safety, and for the safety of Father James, please **keep your mask in place** until after you have received the host, removing your mask only after you have stepped to the side to a marked cross.
