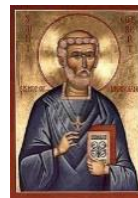

Following many costly investigations, in the last few weeks work has been continuing on solving the problem with flooding in the cellar/kitchen area and toilets in the Parish Centre. Hopefully this problem has now been solved. Supported and guided by the Diocese Property Surveyors, tenders have been sent out recently for fixing the flat roof of the church. Hopefully work will begin in early autumn once approval has been received for this costly work from the Diocese.
